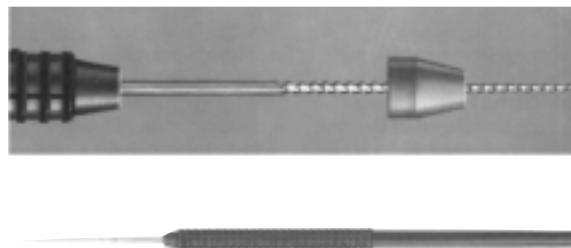


## Ferrule Tools

The handiest tool around for working with the small capillary sized graphite ferrules. The tapered spiral tip allows the tool to be screwed into the capillary sized hole. Despite the small size of the tip, they last a long time. You can usually find other uses for them such as cleaning jet tips.

## Septum Tool

## Coddington 20X Magnifier

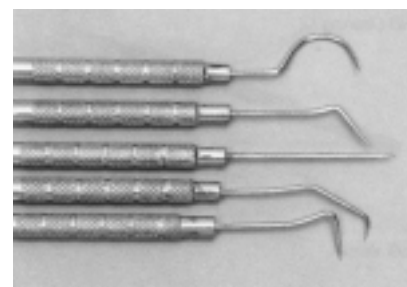
Used to examine liner and column ends to ensure clean cuts.
